Most of us do not realize how accelerated the rate of our lives has become or the speed at which we are driving ourselves. Men and women are destroying their bodies with this pace-and what is even more tragic, their minds and souls as well, for, constant over stimulation produces poison in the body and creates fatigue and emotional illness.

There are times when the only way to check this headlong pace is to stop-abruptly. Everyone should insist upon not less than a quarter-of-an hour of absolute quiet every twenty four hours. As Thomas Carlyle said, "Silence is the element in which great things fashion themselves". Go alone into the quietest place available and sit or lie down for fifteen minutes. Do not talk to any one. Do not read. Think as little as possible. This may be difficult at first because thoughts are stirring up in your mind, but practice will make it easier. Conceive of your mind as the surface of a body of water and see how nearly unruffled you can make it. Then try to listen for the deeper sounds of harmony and beauty and of God, that are to be found in the essence of silence.
